FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners of St. John the Baptist. I write to you from DC this weekend. I arrived here on Saturday with Fr. Martin. I am blessed to have the very same room as last year on the 4th floor of the Theological College. Directly out of my window I can see the façade of the largest Catholic Church in America, the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. This beautiful church has around 80 side chapels and oratories, many dedicated to Our Lady. Its construction was begun in the 1920's and its funding came from thousands of Catholics across our nation and also a large contribution from the Knights of Columbus. The Trinity Dome mosaic was completed in 2017 and many may remember the fundraising drive from the last decade accomplished for this purpose.

Upwards of 9,000 people can fit in the main body of the church and another 4,000 in the crypt. The basilica is always packed in January with hundreds of priests and thousands of faithful for the annual March for Life. During the summer thousands of pilgrims visit the church each day. From my window I can constantly see the numerous people going in and out of the shrine.

Consecrating the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus—Livestream:

From the USCCB: In celebration of the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the U.S. bishops will consecrate the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Thursday, June 11th. The special Mass of consecration, will be livestreamed on the [USCCB's YouTube](#) channel. The bishops' livestream event is intended to be a catalyst to encourage parishes and individuals to participate in the America 250 commemoration by contributing to 250 Hours of Adoration and/or 250 Works of Mercy.

You are encouraged to pray the Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as a nine-day novena beginning on June 3rd. This preparation of praying the consecration prayer for nine days will foster a disposition in which your Act of Consecration will be professed with heart-felt conviction on June 11th. Copies of this novena can be found on the round table in the vestibule.

You are encouraged to pray the Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as a nine-day novena beginning on June 3rd. This preparation of praying the consecration prayer for nine days will foster a disposition in which your Act of Consecration will be professed with heart-felt conviction on June 11th. Copies of this novena can be found on the round table in the vestibule.
