THE DEACON IS SPEAKIN'

The first half of the month of June is a busy one for the church with the first week celebrating important martyrs on three different days.

St. Justin (June 1st) was a pagan convert to Christianity. He wrote in defense of the faith and promoted the truth of Christianity. When he refused to offer sacrifice to the pagan gods, he and his companions were beheaded in the year 165!

June 2nd is the optional memorial of Sts. Marcellinus and Peter who were martyred in the early 4th century during the brutal persecution of the emperor Diocletian.

June 3rd is the memorial of St. Charles Lwanga and companions. They suffered martyrdom in 1886 because of their refusal to perform unnatural acts with a tribal king in Uganda and for continuing to teach and practice their faith.

In the early 8th century, St. Boniface was sent from his home in England to the Netherlands and Germany. While his mission to the Netherlands was not successful, his mission to Germany resulted in many converts, monasteries, and centers of learning. He returned to the Netherlands where he was murdered by pagans in the year 754.

On June 11th, we remember St. Barnabas, companion to St. Paul and instrumental in convincing the Church that St. Paul could be trusted and should be accepted by the early Church.

It is easy to look at these martyrs and to say that this all happened so long ago as to be just a distant memory. Nothing could be further from the truth! We live in the Age of Martyrs!! The Christero War in Mexico, just south of us, ended less than a hundred years ago. People around the world are being killed today because of their faith and in our own country we have seen an increase in hate crimes aimed at various religious institutions including the Catholic Church.

Early June also contains two important Solemnities; Corpus Christi (The Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus) on June 7th and the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 11th.

Also be sure to remember Father Thelen in your prayers as he continues his studies in Canon Law. Pray also for Father Martin as he begins his studies.
